6. Public Hearing to Consider Adoption and Submission of the Groundwater Sustainability Plan (GSP) for the Petaluma Valley Basin to comply with the Sustainable Groundwater Management Act (SGMA) (The Public Hearing Will Start at 5:45 p.m.)

Background: This hearing is to consider the adoption of a GSP covering the Petaluma Valley Basin (DWR Bulletin 118, Groundwater Basin 2-001) pursuant to SGMA. (Cal. Water Code sections 10720-10737.8 et seq.) SGMA authorizes a local agency overlying a groundwater basin to serve as a Groundwater Sustainability Agency (GSA) for that Basin. The Petaluma Valley GSA (PVGSA) overlies all portions of Basin 2-001 in order to sustainably manage the groundwater resources of the Basin. On June 22, 2017 the PVGSA became a GSA for all portions of Basin 2-001 in order to sustainably manage the groundwater resources of the Basin. SGMA further authorizes a GSA to adopt and implement a GSP. A GSP has been developed and is available for download at PetalumaValleyGroundwater.org or for inspection at the GSA Office at 404 Aviation Blvd. Santa Rosa, CA 95403 during regular business hours. Development of the GSP included over 60 public meetings, input from an advisory committee, and outreach to stakeholders, disadvantaged communities, environmental organizations, rural well owners, and local governments.
